HCA HIGHLIGHT: WOOD MULCH AND LEAF COMPOST GIVE BACK PROGRAM

The Host Community Agreement (HCA) outlines the protections and benefits provided to our residents for hosting High Acres Landfill in Perinton. One of those benefits is the Wood Mulch and Leaf Compost Give Back Program.

All of your household yard and tree debris collected weekly by the Town is processed by Waste Management into wood mulch and leaf compost that is given back to the community at no cost. On average, the equivalent of 67,500 bags of material is provided free to Perinton residents each year. Making this material available for reuse saves landfill space and provides a valuable commodity for residents.

Each Friday in May, Perinton Public Works will haul wood mulch and leaf compost in bulk to Perinton Park and the Perinton Community Center. Perinton residents are invited to use this recycled material around their homes each spring and fall.
